This Website serves board members, residents and buyers by

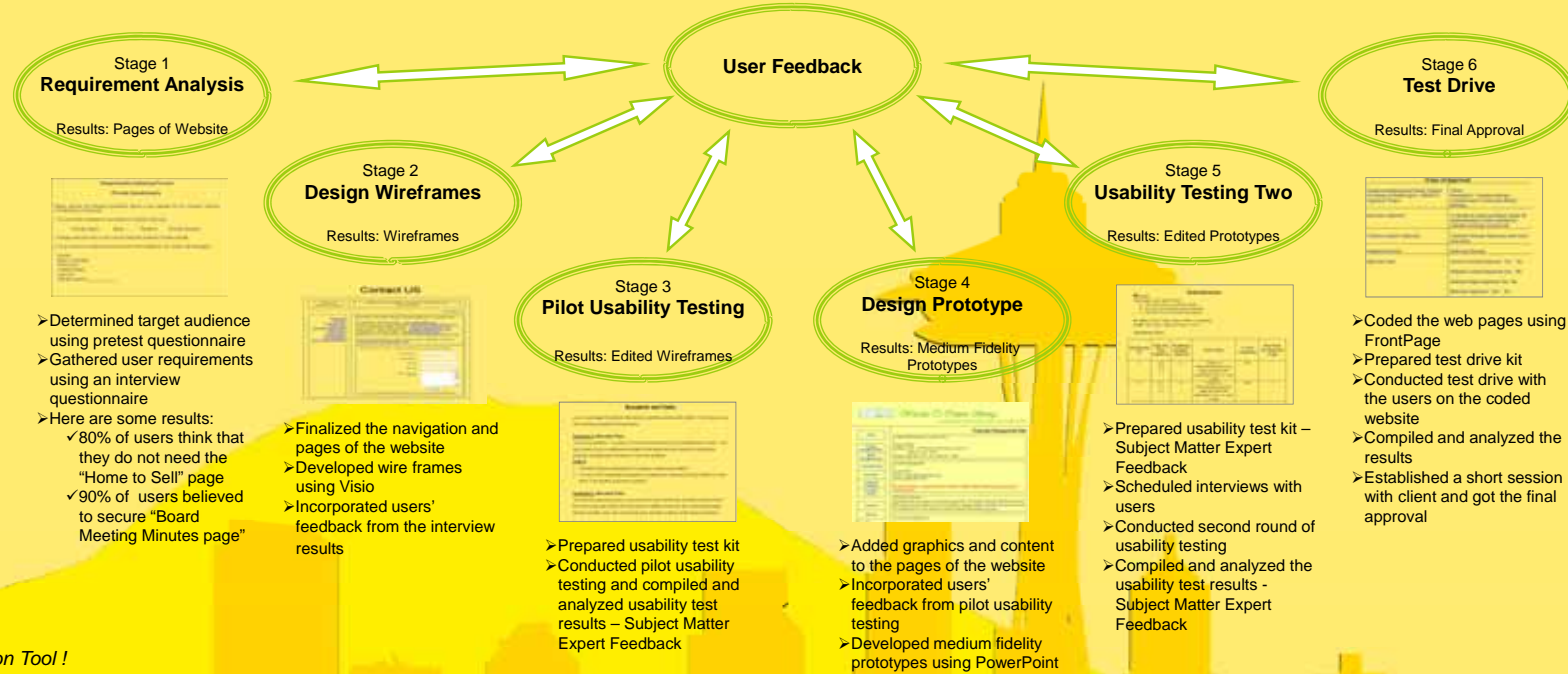
- Enabling the board members to host their meeting schedules and meeting minutes

Back End Design
