  - Organize your job and internship search with our <u>Job Search Tracker</u>
  - Check that you are tailoring your resume with keywords from the job description using Resume Worded (sign in with Google using your UW email)
  - Suggestions for places to begin applying:
    - Prioritize the company/organization's own internship/career website,
      many only post internship program opportunities there
    - <u>UW Handshake</u>\*\* (please note that incoming students will all have access by Fall)
    - <u>LinkedIn</u> (remember to update your LinkedIn profile!)

    - <u>BuiltinSeattle</u> (focused on small-medium sized companies in 'tech hub' cities)
