MLIS Students

- INFX 505 is required of all Residential and Online MLIS students who started in the program in autumn 2012 or later. It is also required of anyone who started earlier and is planning to pursue Capstone (INFX 595 in winter quarter, INFX 596 in spring quarter). - An option to waive out of INFX 505 is available for qualified MLIS students who can demonstrate competencies in project management. You must have coursework or demonstrated experience in project planning, with proof of the ability to develop a project schedule identifying milestones, tasks, resources, dependencies and dates, using a software tool to produce a Gantt Chart.
- To waive out of INFX 505 complete the following form and submit it to the MLIS Academic Advisor prior to the start of fall quarter.
 - If approved you do not need to take INFX 505.
 - If not approved you must plan on taking INFX 505. For Capstone students you will need to take INFX 505 prior to INFX 595 (winter quarter).
