An outdated database

Gay City was using a volunteer made database to organize their books, but it was difficult to browse unless you knew exactly what you were looking for. Clearly, Gay City had outgrown this system and needed a new one!

TinyCat: a big solution

We helped Gay City switch to TinyCat, a web based library system that comes with 24 hr support at a small price tag. Gay City had already begun the process of adding items, so we needed to take inventory. We also added functions on their home page that allow users to browse the books by subject and genre.




Looking for the right read
