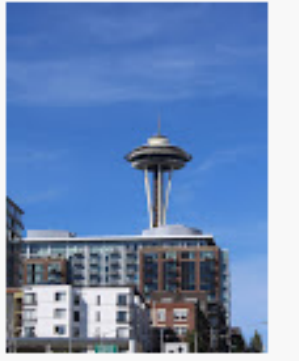

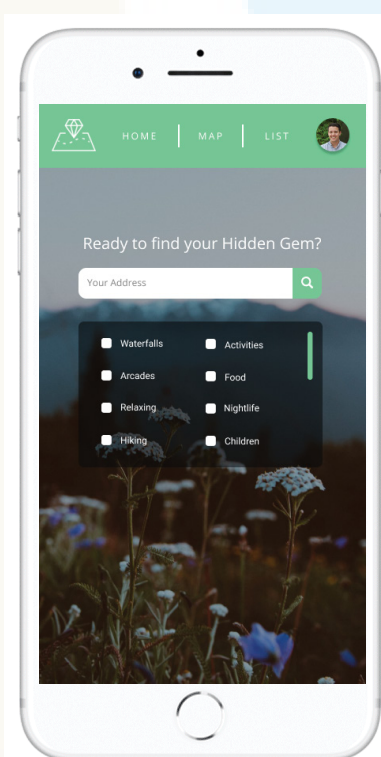

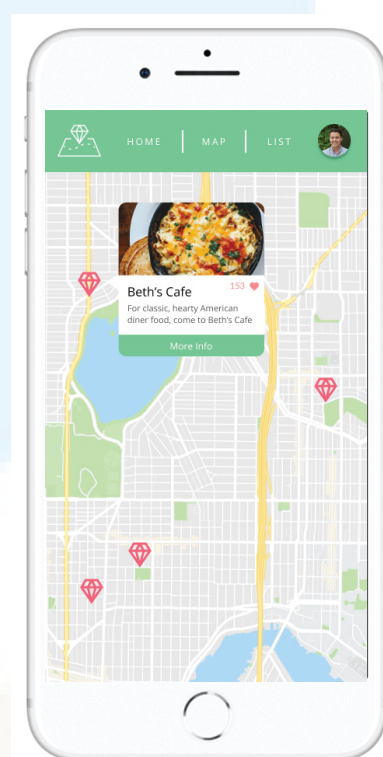

Our Solution

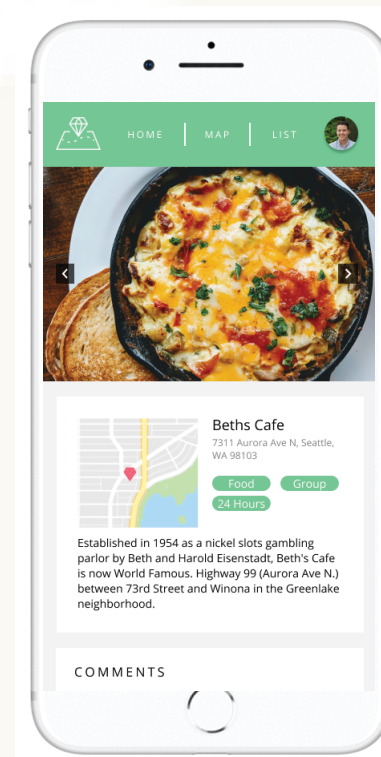
Our solution is to compile a list of all of the "hidden gems" in the Pacific Northwest. We will make it easy for our users to get past all the touristy attractions and find new things to do.



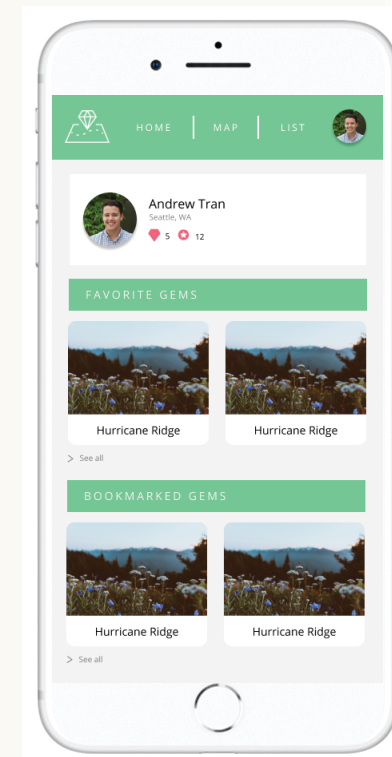
