OVERVIEW

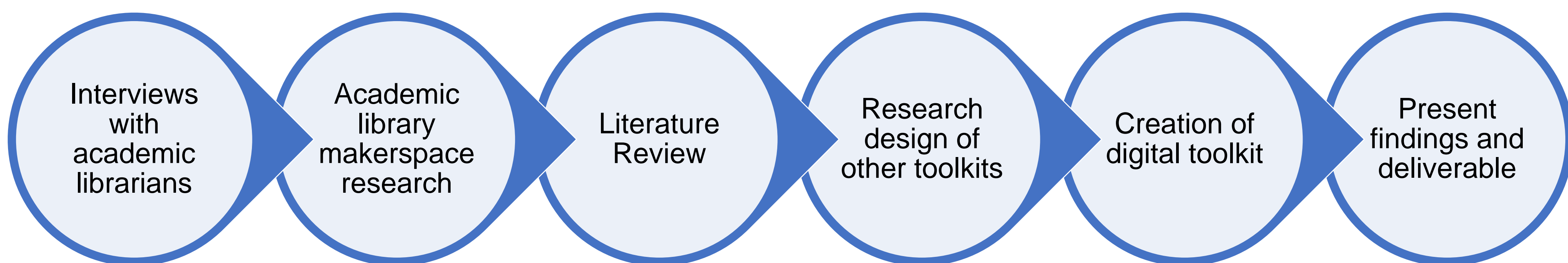
THE PROBLEM

DELIVERABLES

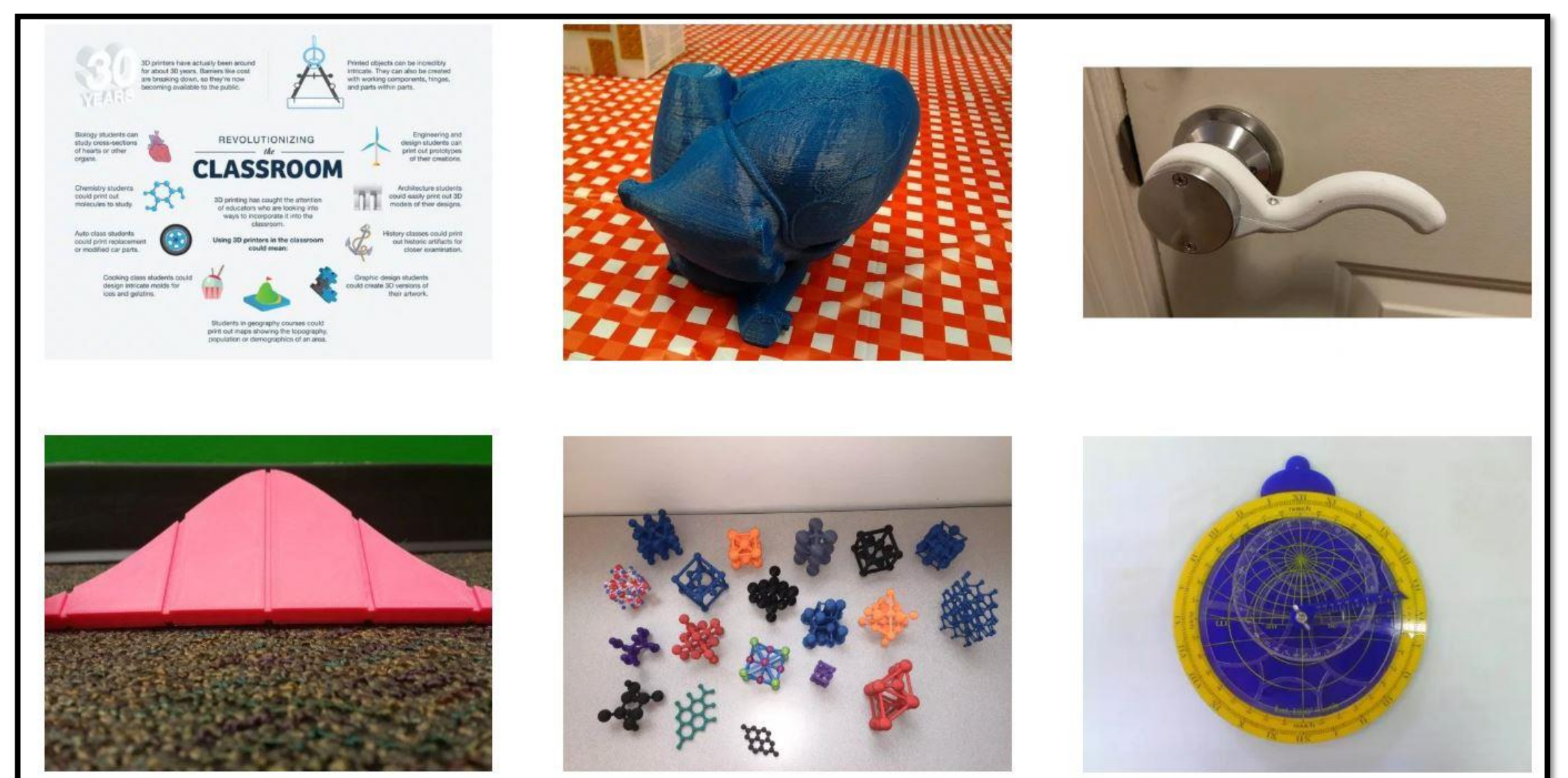
THE TOOLKIT
