**DIAGNOSIS & THERAPY**

**ClinicalKey**  
A clinical insight engine that includes journals, ebooks, practice guidelines, drug information, CME materials, procedural videos, and patient handouts for the health professional.

**DynaMed Plus**  
DynaMed Plus is an evidence-based clinical reference tool. Contains more than 3,400 topic summaries across all disciplines. Updated daily based on surveillance of over 500 journals and critical appraisal of the best articles. Includes Micromedex drug resources. A mobile app is also available.

**Joanna Briggs Library**  
A unique suite of information resources to help integrate evidence into your practice. Includes publications such as best practice information sheets, evidence summaries, and systematic reviews.

**SEARCH FOR ARTICLES**

**MEDLINE Complete with Full Text**  
MEDLINE Complete is the largest companion to the MEDLINE index and contains full text for thousands of journals included in the index. This collection also provides full text for many of the most used medical journals.

**PubMed MEDLINE searching**  
PubMed provides access to the MEDLINE bibliographic database. If you are logged in to HEALWA, search results retrieved via this link will also link directly to any full text articles that HEALWA provides.

**INFORMATION FOR PATIENTS**

**MedlinePlus - Health Information for Patients**  
Authoritative information for patients and health consumers from the US National Library of Medicine, the National Institutes of Health (NIH), and other government agencies and health-related organizations.

**MedlinePlus Health Information in Other Languages (for patients)**

**Patient Education Reference Center**  
Patient Education Reference Center? (PERC) features a comprehensive collection of current, evidence-based patient education information for clinicians to print and distribute right at the point-of-care. The handouts provided by PERC are easy to read, include illustrations, and are structured to enhance patient knowledge and understanding of material. These handouts can also be accessed through Nursing Reference Center?

**DRUGS**

**Drug Information Portal**  
From the US National Library of Medicine. Searches more than a dozen sources for information about more than 12,000 drugs.

**LactMed**  
A peer-reviewed and fully referenced database of drugs to which breastfeeding mothers may be exposed. Among the data included are maternal and infant levels of drugs, possible effects on breastfed infants and on lactation, and alternate drugs to consider.

**Pillbox**  
Pillbox enables rapid identification of unknown solid-dosage medications (tablets/capsules) based on physical characteristics and high-resolution images. Once a medication is identified, Pillbox provides links to drug information and drug labels.

**COMPLEMENTARY & ALTERNATIVE MEDICINE**

**Natural Medicines, (formerly Natural Standard)**  
Natural Medicines is an authoritative resource available on dietary supplements, natural medicines, and complementary, alternative, and integrative therapies.

**MULTICULTURAL INFORMATION**

**EthnoMed**  
The EthnoMed site contains information about cultural beliefs, medical issues and other related issues pertinent to the health care of recent immigrants to Seattle or the US, many of whom are refugees fleeing war-torn parts of the world. It includes information for patients as well as for providers.

**HealthReach**  
HealthReach is a national collaborative partnership that has created a resource of quality multilingual, multicultural public health information for those working with or providing care to individuals with limited English proficiency.

## The Information Opportunity

HEALWA is a one-of-a-kind online medical library funded through Washington State practitioner licensing fees, and is available to eligible providers at no additional cost.

In 2018, only 13.4% of over 200,000 eligible healthcare professionals were registered users. How can HEALWA attract new users and increase utilization of their resources?

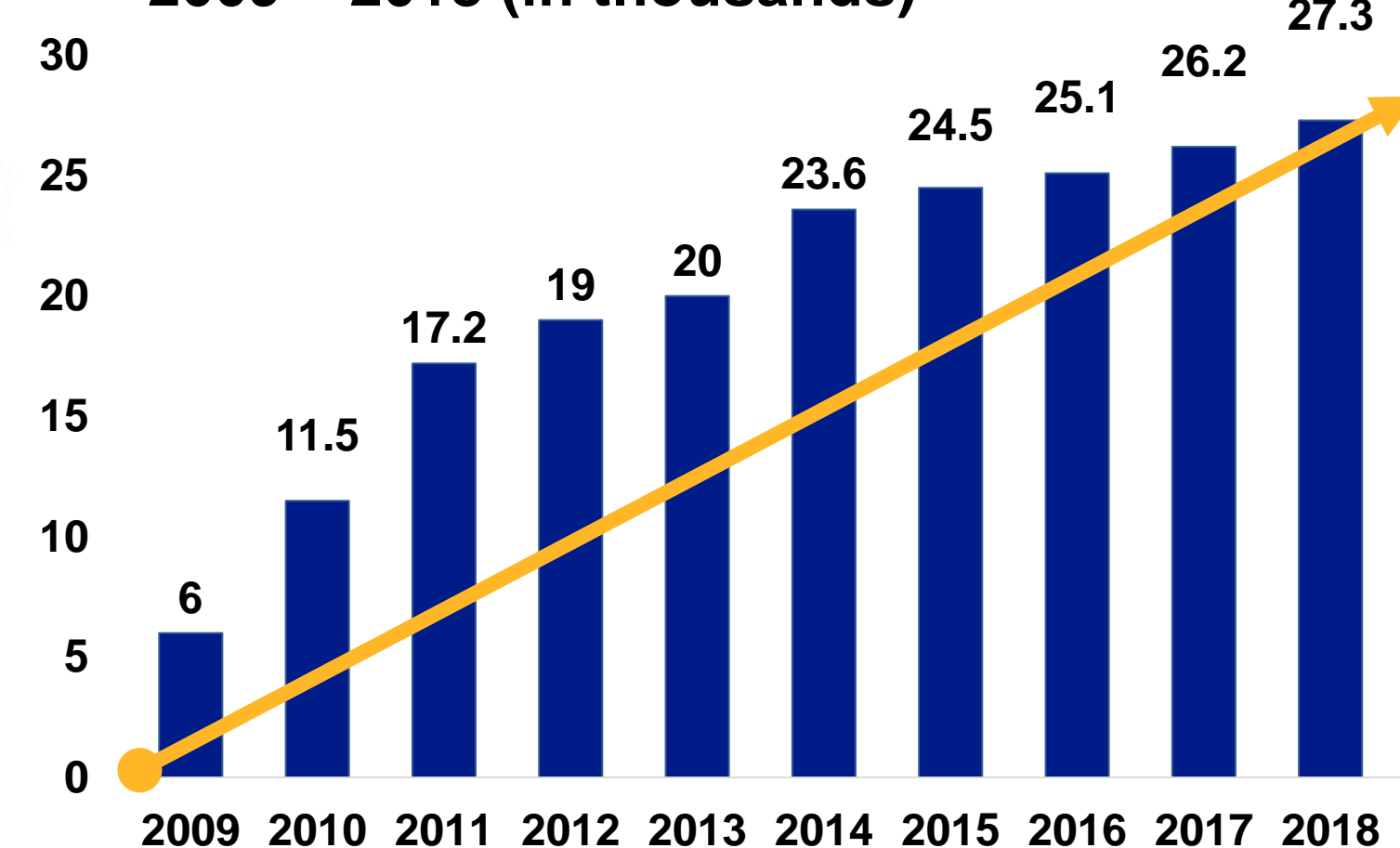
## The Impact
