

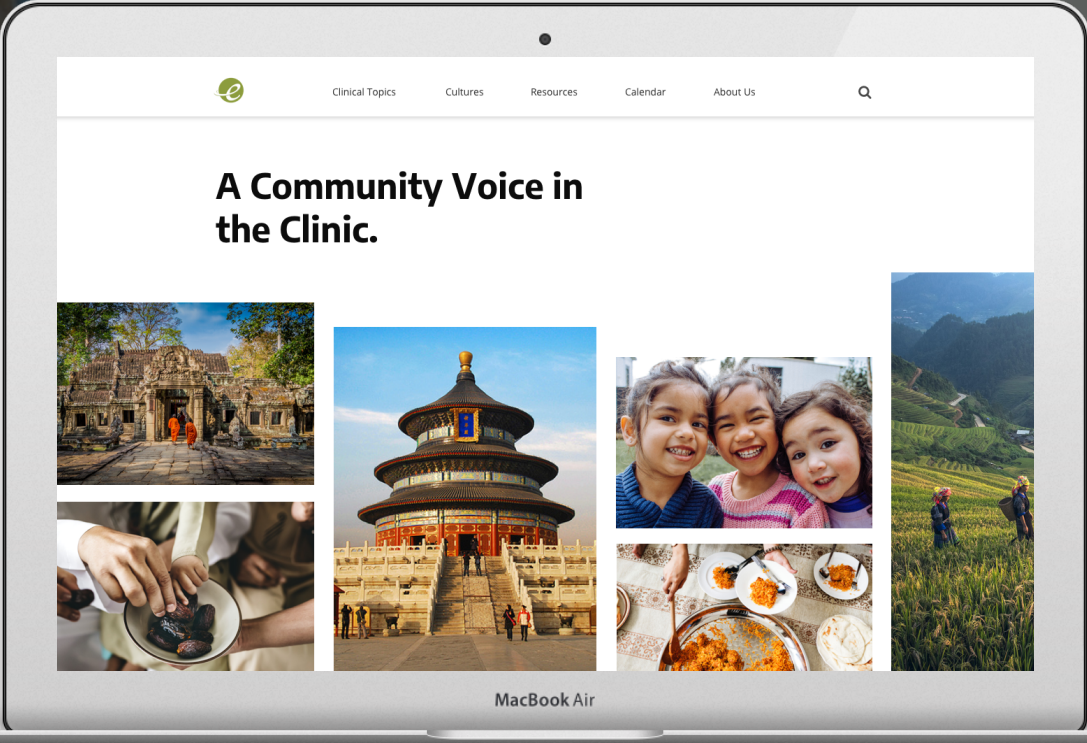
EthnoMed 2.0



Navigating through cross-cultural healthcare information at ease and with speed

PROJECT GOAL

EthnoMed is a program of Harborview Medical Center and the University of Washington Health Sciences Libraries, focused on reducing health disparities among refugee and immigrant communities. The program’s website has been struggling with its poor user experience and site usage. The goal of the project is to help the program hear its site users’ inner voice through in-depth and well-designed user research and transform this voice into a user-friendly website.



OUR APPROACH

By identifying target user groups, digging into users’ pain points with extensive user research, crafting and iterating the website based on users’ feedback, we came up with a refreshed design - EthnoMed 2.0. The new design not only brings a new look and feel to the site, but also improves the site’s information architecture and navigation, allowing providers to find information easily and quickly, thus attracting and retaining more users to the website.
