## Knowledge Gap



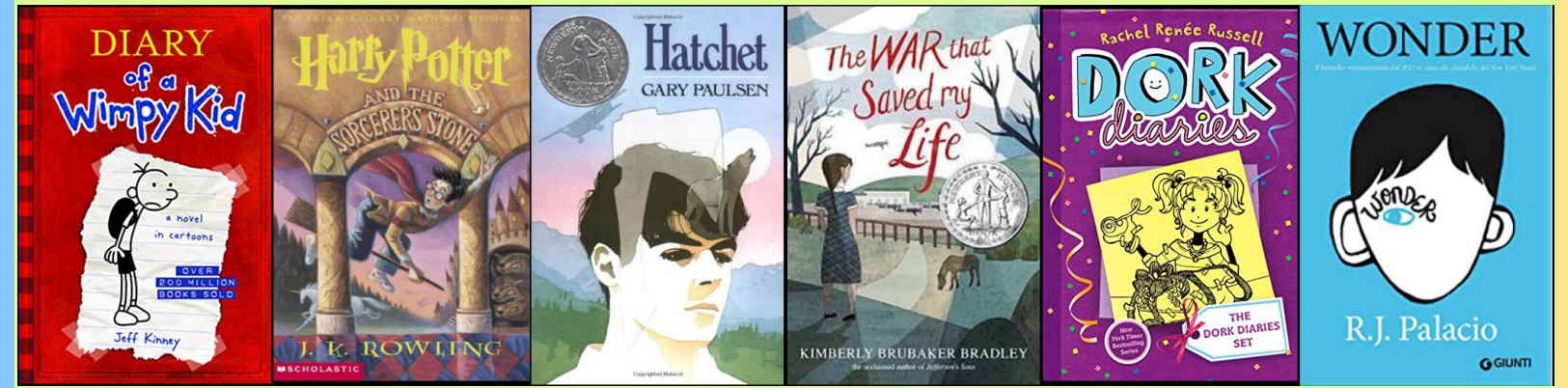
Readers growing into one collection from another may not know popular authors or titles to try.
