







A personalized collection plan to promote engagement with material and the library space.

Challenges:


- Tight shelves make it difficult for patrons to find or browse material.
- The Library Director would like DVD's to be less prominent in children's area.


Opportunities:


- Appropriate weeding will provide opportunities to feature material.

Challenges:

Allocation of space for the material type doesn't match circulation usage.

Opportunities:
