

# TACOMA COMMUNITY HOUSE LIBRARY PROJECT

Tacoma Community House is a nonprofit organization serving local community members, immigrants, and refugees through education; immigration and employment support; and crime victim advocacy. We created a library on site to support TCH clients, instructors, staff, and volunteers with supplementary educational materials as well as general reading resources in English and a variety of the clients' native languages.
