Covered Scalar's key features, use cases, strengths, limitations, accessibility concerns, how Scalar compares to other web publishing platforms, and more.

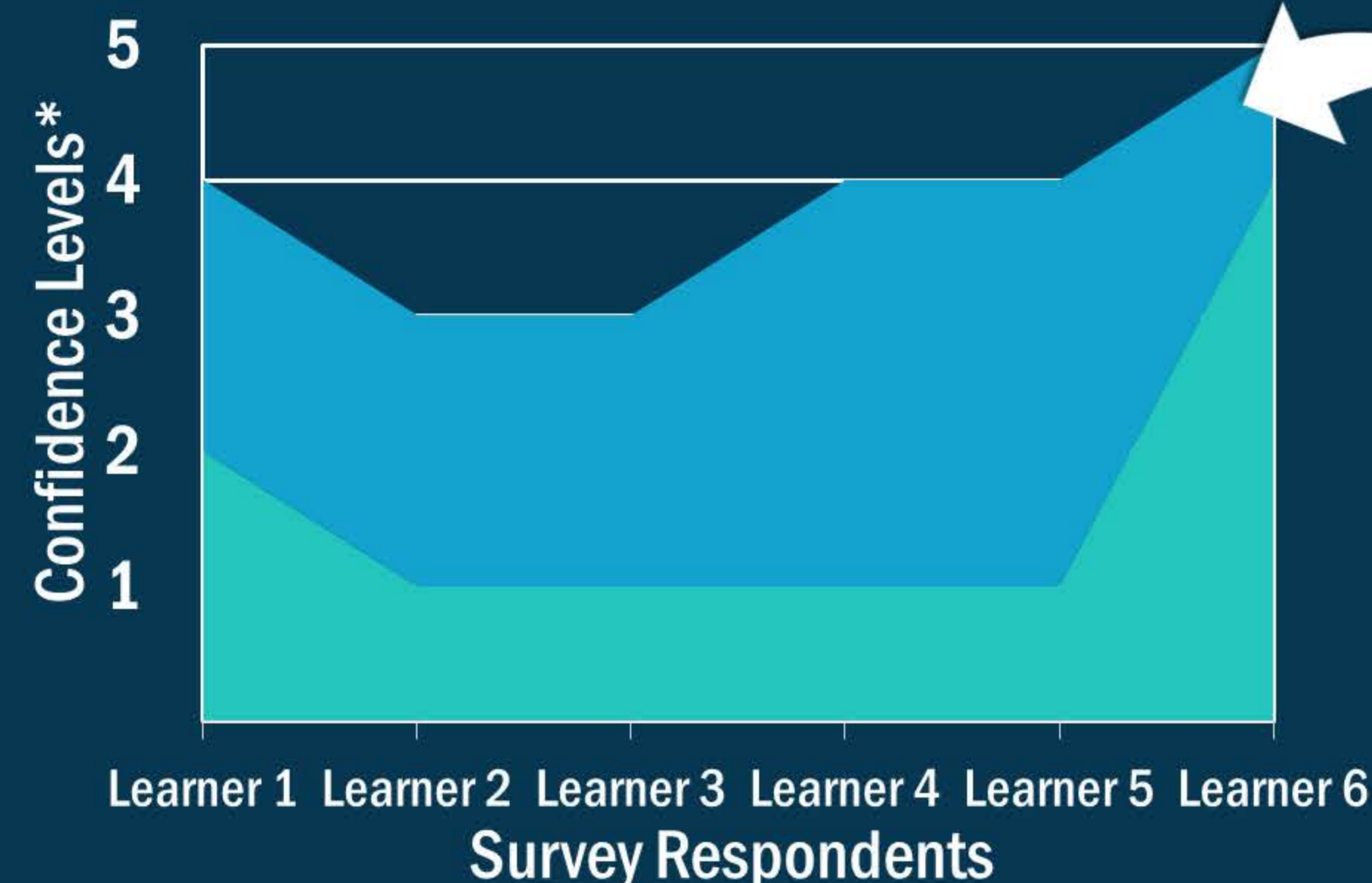
Taught an interactive online workshop with an informational presentation, demonstration, exploration activities, and build-a-book exercises.
