

How Common are ACEs?

KEY FINDINGS

In California, 61.7% of adults have experienced at leas one ACE and one in six, or 16.7%, have experienced four or more ACEs. The most common ACE among California adults is emotional (or verbal) abuse.

26.1% Substance abuse by household me
19.9% Physical abuse
17.5% Witness to domestic violence
15.0% Household member with mental illness
11.4% Sexual abuse

Original ACE Study - 1995-1997

The CDC-Kaiser Permanente Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE) Study is one of the largest investigations of childhood abuse and neglect and household challenges and later-life health and wellbeing.

ACEs are common across all populations. Almost twothirds of study participants reported at least one ACE, and more than one in five reported three or more ACEs.

The Solution:

Develop a system to

- gather employees' answers to the ACEs questions
- Compile the results into visualizations that accurately compares the companies standing to the national average

From the results, Transforming Connections is able to provide a customized TIC action plan to the organization.

We chose Survey Gizmo and Tableau. The two programs work well together and enable HIPAA compliance. It is crucial to guard the identity of employees and keep the database secure.
