SHP 2.0: Optimizing Internal Communication at the Worcester Public Library

The Problem:

The Worcester Public Library (WPL) in Worcester, Massachusetts, has an internal website (intranet) called the Staff Home Page (SHP), and its purpose is to facilitate internal communication and knowledge-sharing. However, this communication method is underutilized, outdated, disorganized, and not intuitive. Internal communication is conducted primarily via email. The absence of an effective, centralized communication and knowledge-sharing channel makes it difficult for staff to access the information they need to meaningfully assist and inform the community.

Phase 1 User Research

Needs Assessment Survey

- 24 questions relating to SHP usage, usability, and improvements
- 32 responses from staff members from various departments

Interviews

• Five interviews with various department staff (four via Zoom, one in-person) consisting of five open-ended questions relating to SHP usage, usability, and improvements

The Solution:

We delivered a two-phase consultative report to guide redesigning the SHP, detailing:

- researched intranet best practices
- summarized findings from user research with WPL staff
- highlights from a redesigned intranet concept
- recommendations for redesigning the SHP and subsequent rollout
- out-of-scope recommendations curated from staff feedback

Findings

- SHP is not intuitive, user-friendly, comprehensive, organized, updated, or used to its full potential
- Suggestions: update content, intuitive layout, uniform departmental information, improved search
