APPROACH

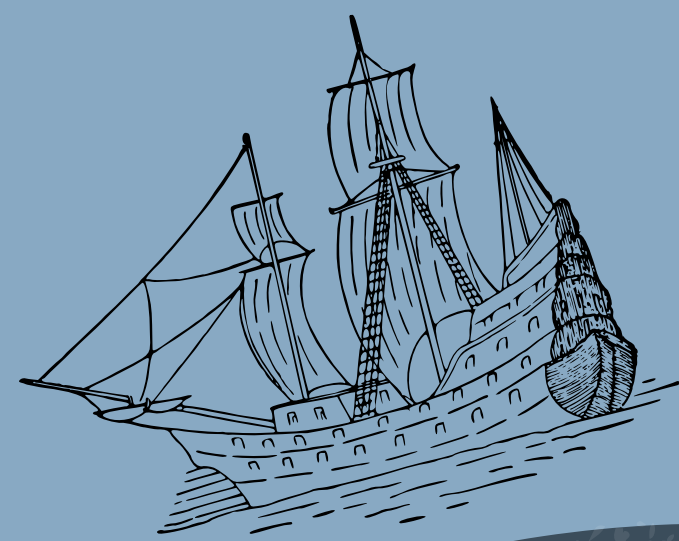
Catalog and embed metadata for voyage slides into Burke Museum's Database for Cultural Collection.

Sixth Voyage of the Brigantine Yankee

The Brigantine Yankee's sixth voyage was an "Around the World Cruise" that lasted from 1953 - 1955.

During its final voyage, The Brigantine Yankee would run aground at Avarua Rarotonga of the Cook Islands on July 24th 1964.
