Digitizing Vinyl in the Seattle Pacific University Archive

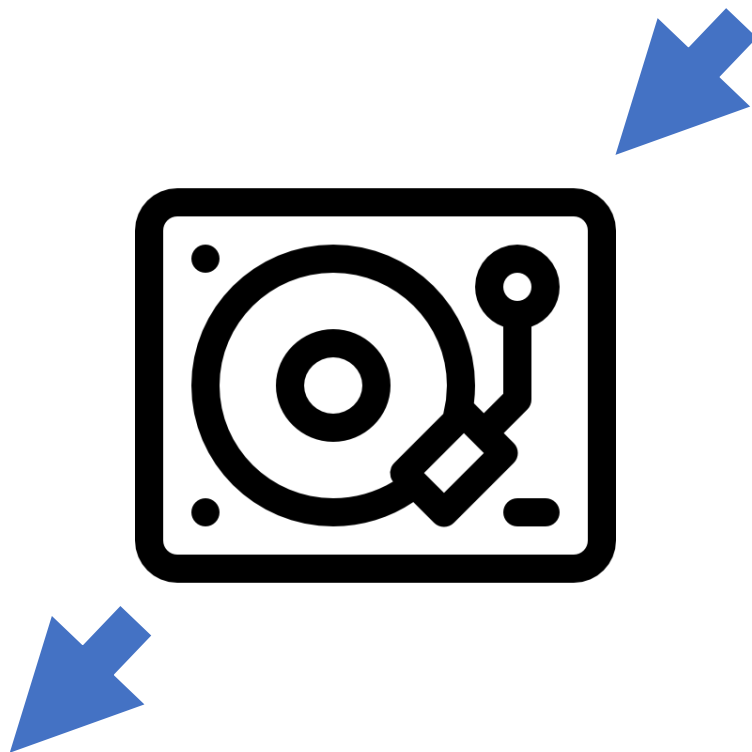
## Background

The Seattle Pacific University Archive contains materials from the founding of the University in 1891 up to the present. Adrienne Meier works half time as University Archivist, and half as liaison librarian of History.



In 2018 an intern helped clean and organize a collection of vinyl records, created by University music groups over the years. I continued this project, digitizing the records and creating a workflow.

I digitized the records using the program Audacity, I applied metadata with the priority of accessibility, and I described a workflow with a “more product, less process” philosophy.



These records will now be much easier to access. The SPU community and researchers of all kinds stand to benefit. The next step is to determine whether these recordings can be hosted on the library’s Digital Commons site.
