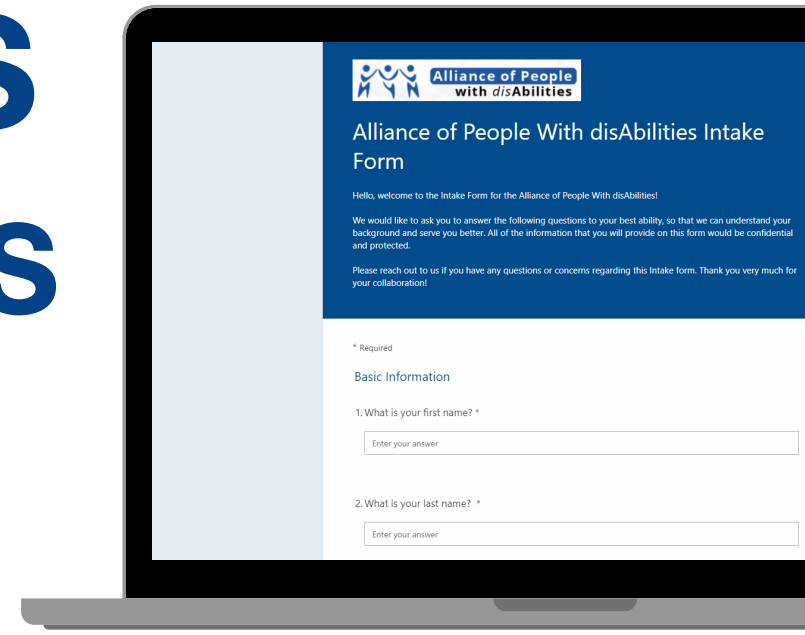


ACCESSIBLE FORMS *for* PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

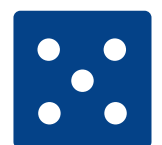

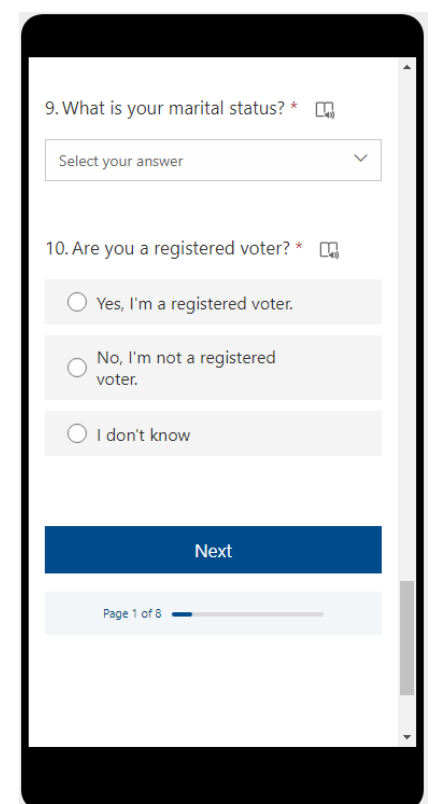
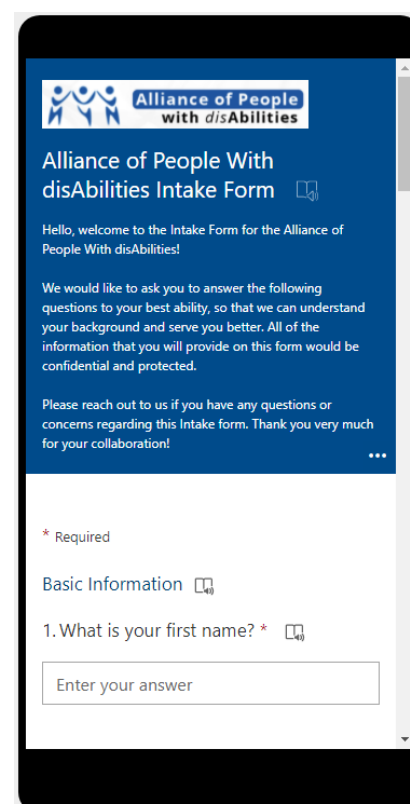
