

### Troublesome Perceptions

- Librarians are "happy to have... no further involvement with the Friends."
- Librarians do not want to invest in Friends, or feel they are "more trouble than they are worth."
- Friends want to have control over library programs, particularly if their group connects to a specific library.

Librarians have some responsibility to the Friends.

-Interface with Friends Survey Response

- The Library should invest in Friends
- Friends have no control over library programming.
- Clear, firm boundaries and defined contact methods show where Friends role stops, where Library role begins.
