



Survey Results

Most survey respondents were able to name three or more issues faced by international students. These issues fell primarily into two categories.

LANGUAGE: communication in general, as well as understanding academic and library jargon.

CULTURE: differing expectations from their home institution and unfamiliarity with standards of plagiarism and citations.
