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## **The Project**

- What is the best way to display the collection to users?
- How should the library keep the collection organized?
- What do library users want from the collection?
- How should the library add to the collection?

The Wasilla Public Library moved into a new facility in September 2016, with a new dedicated space for graphic novels, comics, and manga. However, many questions cropped up after the move.

Wasilla Public Library has no formal procedures in place to answer those questions, and with only three accredited librarians on staff, little time to dedicate to this problem. This project was designed to find the answers by assessing the needs and wants of the community as well as current best practices to create a comprehensive set of goals related to areas of policy, acquisition, and cataloging for graphic novels, comics, and manga.

- Organized purchase list of over 200 essential titles for the collections




