## About the Project

February 16, 2018 will mark the 150th anniversary of Edward Curtis' birth. To celebrate and to increase awareness of the organization and its library, the Mazamas wanted an online exhibit of the photographs that both Edward Curtis and his brother Asahel Curtis took of the Mazamas outings and donated to the organization while they were active members between the years 1895-1908.





- 1. Research virtual exhibit platforms, photography digitization, and metadata standards
- 2. Assess and scan photograph collection and record relevant metadata during on-site visit
- 3. Create and apply watermark to scanned photographs, convert final images from TIFF to JPEG

- 4. Upload photographs to Omeka
- 5. Write website content, including Mazamas and Curtis brother biographies, and narratives for individual expeditions
- 6. Transfer metadata into Dublin Core records for each item
- 7. Publish virtual exhibit and make public



- Increase awareness of the Mazamas mountaineering organization
- Increase awareness of the Mazamas Library & Historical Collections, for both the members of the Mazamas and for the general public
- Allow the public to view and search rarely seen early photography of two prominent local photographers
