


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## Description

- 1. EBCL administration expresses "desperate need" for a Strategic Plan
- 2. Dialogue defines scope of project:
  - Create staff buy-in
  - Synthesize existing data (old plans, survey results, etc.)
  - Gather new data
  - Research industry standards to create modern Strategic Plan template
  - Deliver complete working outline of a plan with clear guidelines for next steps

An up-to-date Strategic Plan helps the Library District prioritize decision making to align its service responses with community needs and goals





Starting the Strategic Planning process in a gradual, unobtrusive way makes it seem less intimidating to the library administration and staff
