AUDIO ARCHIVING FOR MUSIC PRODUCER, RANDALL DUNN

1. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Prolific musician and music producer, Randall Dunn, possesses a collection of dozens of hard drives containing recording sessions that he has overseen and/or participated in over the past nineteen years of his career.

The aim of this project has been:

to design a cataloguing schema;
to log all pertinent metadata to highlight the content of the drives;



2. PROCESS

The workflow of this project was informed by:

 outreach to archiving professionals who work with audio materials;

 research into like-minded projects;

• existing documentation on institutional audio preservation workflows.

to outline a digital preservation
 plan with formal recommendations
 for the next phases of the project.

3. OUTCOMES

It was determined that:

• this scale and type of project is unique;

• adaptations of existing formal recommendations would be necessary to account for project scope limitations.

4. NEXT STEPS

• review the contents of his career catalog;

pinpoint items whose location was previously unknown (for distribution to involved parties and formal record releases);
select items of greatest value for further preservation action.

Deliverables:

 A revised formal digital preservation plan (original was created prior to this project, and was then revised accordingly);

the drives and their contents was built and fleshed out as a reference tool.
