







- The Problem -

Internet-based social networking services like Facebook have surged in popularity over the previous decade, and while more people than ever are using these tools to connect with their friends and family, these platforms are lacking when it comes to supporting engagement between users based on mutual interests for daily, location-based activities.

We created a multi-platform mobile application to help our users connect with others who share similar interests. OnTheFly allows users to create, browse, and join events in their neighborhood, with privacy settings that allow them to choose whether their events are visible to the entire OnTheFly community or just their existing friends. Facebook integration allows users to take advantage of their existing social network, and helps provide a simple and intuitive user experience.






- Future Work -
