## Finding Their Way An Information Guide for New Refugees in Southern Nevada

## Project Description

Recognized an information gap, where no physical guide existed for new refugees to comfortably and easily navigate the city of Las Vegas, NV and access resources they needed.

Created an information resource guide intended to aid refugee families find their way to a successful future in their new city.

Designed to be used by new refugees for locating useful resources, and to be easily translated into other languages.

Can be used digitally for quick electronic reference, or printed for those not comfortable using digital resources.

## Methodology

Input & collaboration: worked with CCSN to identify the information problem and potential solutions.


**Research:** reviewed existing guides to determine which topics (types of information) to include.

Data gathering: collected descriptions and directional information about agencies and organizations according to chosen topics.

Design: created a design template using the fonts and colors from CCSN's website.

Revisions & improvements: incorporated CCSN's comments and finalized the design elements.

## Outcomes

The complete guide contains detailed information for new refugees, such as:

Government resources (state, local, and federal), school district information, child care services, ethnic food markets, library branch and service information, legal resources, immigration resources, health insurance navigation, social services, elderly care, and much more.



Impact & Next Steps

**Translate:** CCSN will translate the guide into common languages, such as Arabic, Amharic, Congolese and others.

**Print & Distribute:** It can be printed and distributed to refugees in need, in their own language.

The Future: CCSN can revise, update, and distribute the guide to other regional chapters of their organization.

**Model:** Guide can serve as a model for other resettlement organizations across the country.
