alternatives do not offer the best options for all users



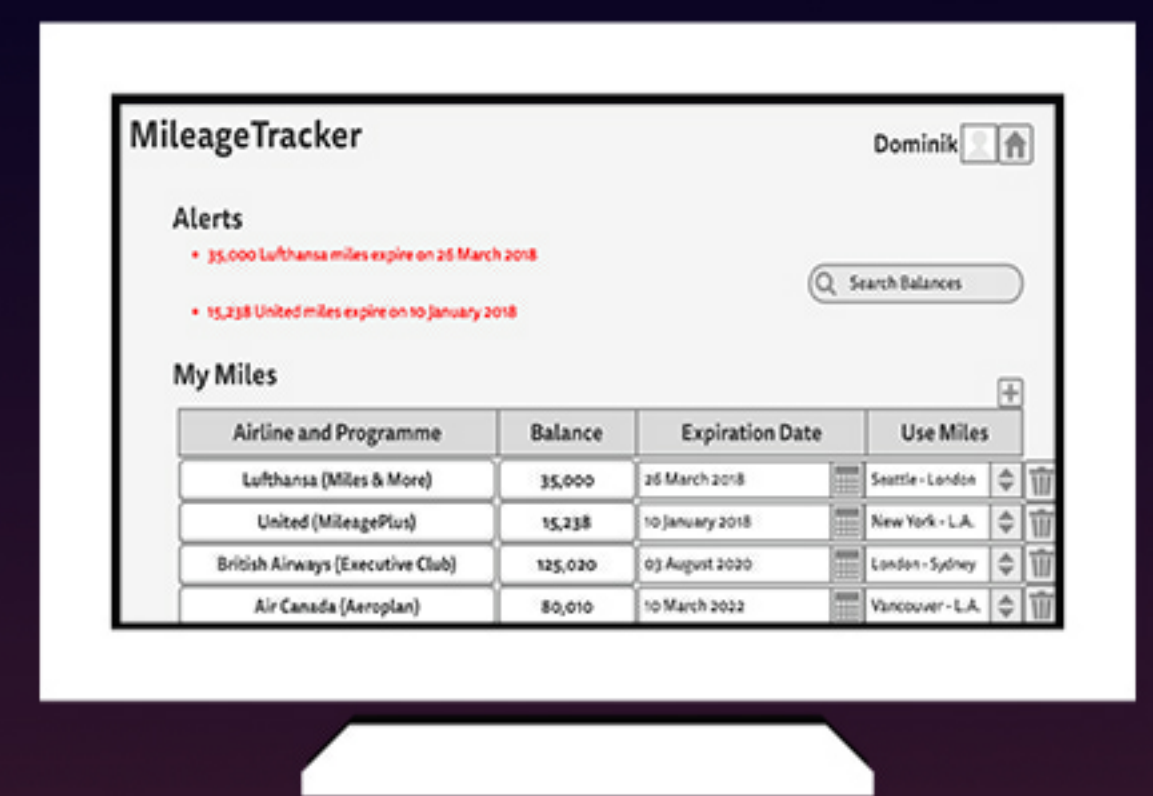
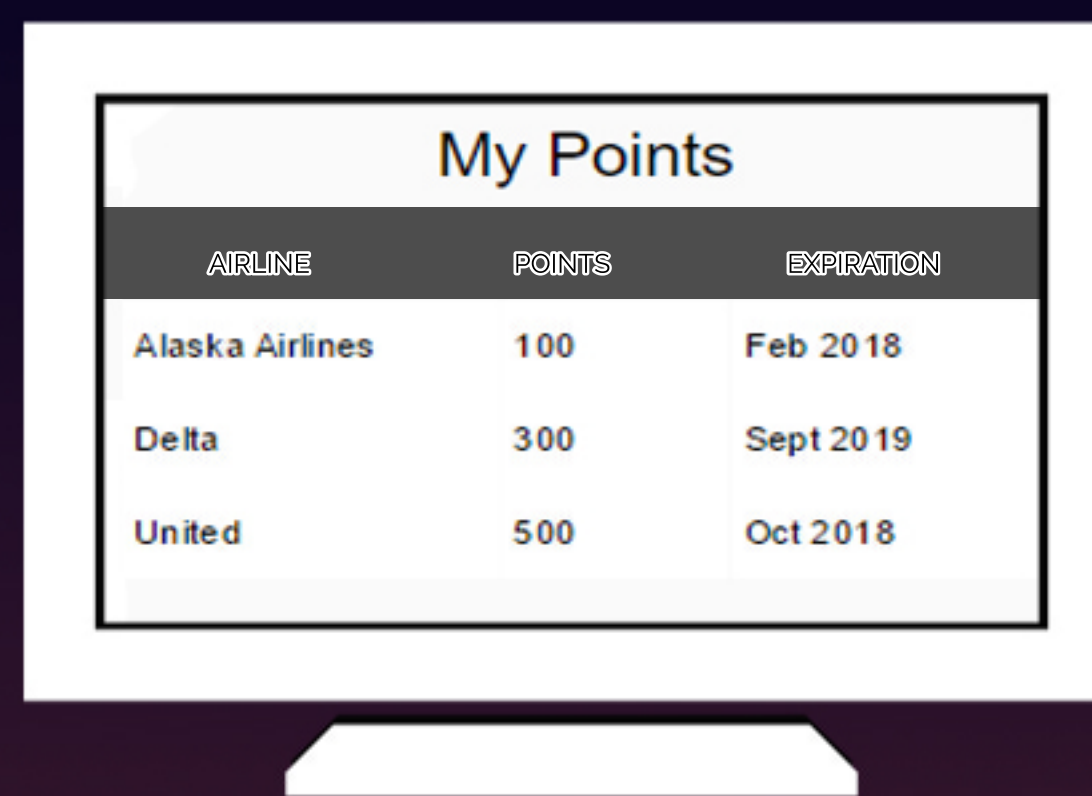
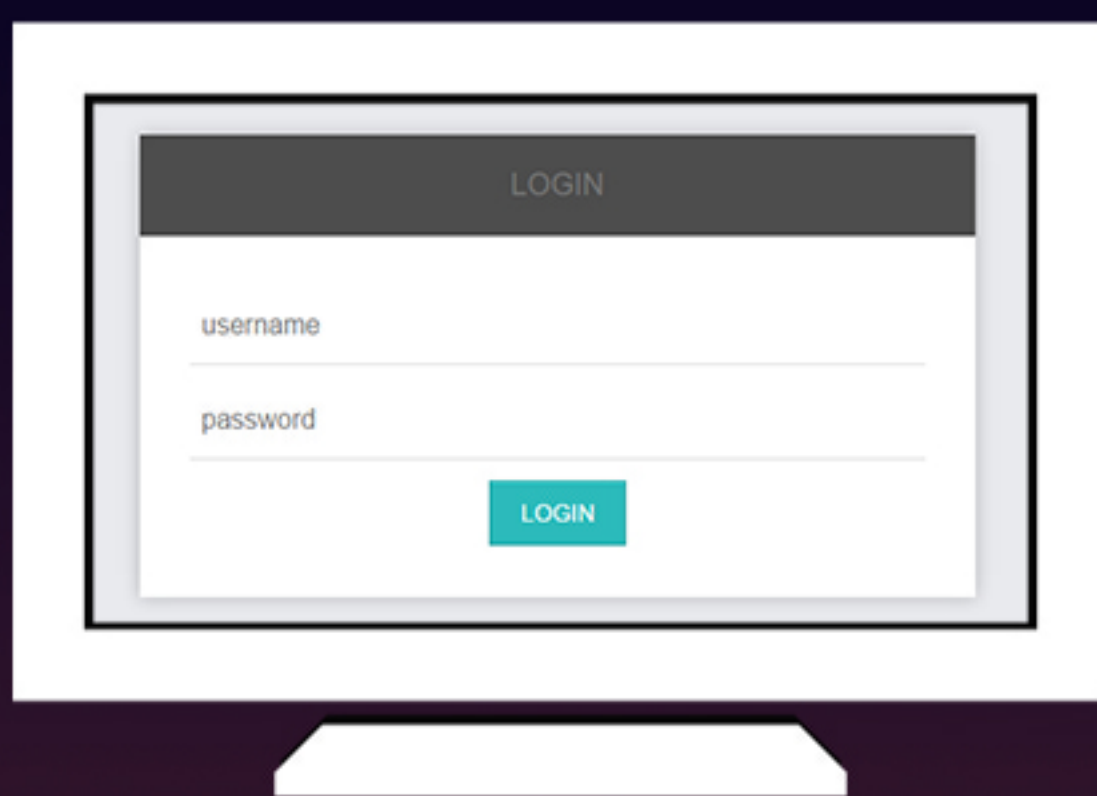
### Difficult
